How Parents Can Help

 Please read to your child every day and comment in their reading record.
Example: He/she enjoyed the book. He/she could talk about the pictures or characters.



MATHEMATICS

- Counting objects and identifying how many there are
- Linking numerals and amounts (showing the right numbers of objects to match the numeral, up to 5).
- Extending and creating patterns (leaf, stick, leaf, stick).



COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE

- Using longer sentences of four to six words.
- Being able to express a point of view using words as well as actions.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Talk about their feelings using words like 'happy', 'sad', 'angry' or 'worried'.
- Begin to understand how others might be feeling.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

• Being increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed, for example, putting coats on and doing up zips.



LITERACY

- Engaging in extended conversations about stories, learning new vocabulary
- Using some of their print and letter knowledge in their early writing. For example: writing a pretend shopping list that starts at the top of the page; write 'm' for mummy.
- Writing some or all of their name.




