COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE


- The children will be encouraged to use longer sentences of four to six words.
- The children will learn to express a point of view using words as well as actions.


PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT



- The children will express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.
- They will learn how to show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.
- They will learn how to identify and moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT





 They will also learn to develop confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball.

MATHEMATICS

- The children will explore the composition of numbers to 8
- They will learn to automatically recall number bonds for numbers 0-8
- Children will explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including even and odd numbers.

LITERACY

- Children will read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter-sound correspondences
- They will spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s.
- Children will write short sentences with words with known letter-sound correspondences

PHONICS

- Children will review the sounds i/v/y/w/v/x/z
- They will learn the sounds sh, th, ch, qu, ng, nk
- They will learn to read CCVC words e.g. splash, frog and CVCC words e.g. hunt, fast.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

- Children will explore seasonal changes focussing on Spring
- They will explore the natural world around them.
- They will describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.
- Children will learn to draw information from a simple map.

EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN

- The children will learn to create collaboratively sharing ideas, resources and skills.
- They will listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.
