## MATHEMATICS

- Children will explore place value within 50.
- They will also look at measurement – length and height, mass and volume.
- Children will also revisit previously taught units through daily Maths Meetings.



## COMPUTING

- The children will continue to use Purple Mash to learn about coding and algorithms.



## MUSIC

- Children will develop their coordination through dancing and singing games.
- They will be using their voices and instruments to repeat the tune.
- They will learn a new song called Round And Round, a Bossa Nova Latin style.



## RE

- Children will continue learning about how different communities express beliefs and values through food.



## ENGLISH

- Our focus story is Sally and the Limpet by Simon James. The children will use it to write a short narrative.
- Children will read and create their own version of the poem 'The Magic Box'.
- Reading & Phonics: Children will continue daily phonics and reinforce their reading through Daily Supported Reading.
- Spelling: learn how to read, write and spell the Y1 common exception words.



## PHYSICAL EDUCATION
