Maths

- Children will continue to develop arithmetic skills
- Children will be developing their reasoning skills in preparation for upcoming SATs
- Children will deepen their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages including conversion, equivalencies and finding amounts using reasoning skills
- Children will also be introduced to algebraic formulas and expressions



Computing

- Children will be exploring Blogging. They will look at what a blog is, how they are used, and how they are created.



Music

- Children will be looking at You Got A Friend by Carole King
- Children will be developing their instrumental skills by using a recorder to perform this song



Religion

- The children will continue with their learning of Christianity through the death and resurrection of Jesus
- They will learn about the importance of Easter in the Christian Faith



English

- Children will be focusing on the texts Julius Caesar by William Shakespeare and Cosmic by Frank Cottrell- Boyce
- They will be writing a persuasive letter to encourage the senate to plot against Julius Caesar
- Children will persuade tourists to come and visit a lunar theme park through a Trip Advisor Advert
- Children will be learning to build stamina within their writing as well as making their writing cohesive and structured by using their publishing and editing skills



Physical Development

History
